Pace of Play

Vi Kemp, rules chairperson for WMSG, gave tips for speeding up play.

- **Hit and Sit.** The last person in the group hits their ball and sits in the cart without putting away the clubs in her hands. At the next tee, she puts her clubs away.
- If a person in your group has lost a ball, hit your ball before going to help look for the lost ball.
- Play ready golf. Whoever gets to the ball first, go ahead and hit.
- If you are not keeping score, hit your ball while scorers record scores.
- If your group is near the green, keep all carts (hand pushed and ride on) close to the green instead of putting them near the next tee box.
