6. Special Tournament, President's Cup: Diane Herring Clarification of Rules for President's Cup Play

- a. We play preferred lies just like regular Thursday tournaments.
- b. On hole #2, since this is a special tournament, we must play USGA rules and hit over the water. There is no drop area for the President's Cup. If the ball goes into the pond, you must hit again. Following the rules of golf, the yellow stakes indicate a hazard area. Act accordingly. At any point you can just pick up the ball and concede the hole. Keep in mind that you have lost only one hole by doing this.

Thanks were given to Diane for painting and giving balls to participants in the President's Cup Tournament.

There is an issue with the posting of President's Cup scores into the computer. Should the scores be posted as HOME tournament scores or TOURNAMENT scores? After discussion, Gwen Archambault made the motion that this matter be turned over to Sue Roberts, handicapper, and a committee which she will select. Anne Pooler seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Executive Committee Motion: Robin Ashe

During the Executive Committee meeting held on June 27th, the Special Tournaments section of the Standing Rules in the Member Booklet was discussed. The first sentence states, "Member must have played in at least 3 weekly Thursday tournaments during the past 12 months." We discussed this opening sentence. It was our consensus to strike this sentence from the wording.

Rationale

We want no stipulations that prevent players from participating in our special tournaments, or from recording their scores on the ringer board, the chip-in booklet, and the birdie tree. We want to encourage participation; not prevent it. We have members who are still working. They may not be able to participate in our regular tournaments. but will be able to participate in special tournaments. We want to encourage all of our members to participate as their schedule allows.

Anne Pooler made the motion that the first sentence of the Special Tournaments section of the Standing Rules in the Member Booklet be eliminated. Karen Bamford seconded the motion. After discussion, members voted to approve the motion. The motion carried.
