Welcome: President, Robin Ashe

After greeting us, Robin talked about Aristotle thoughts on the kinds of friendship there are and how his thoughts apply to our golf club.

Reports:

1. Secretary's Report: Gwen Archambault

The secretary's report for the September meeting can be found on our website at http://www.liz44.com/bangorgolf/index.htm. Members have been able to read the minutes from the July 25th monthly meeting by receiving them at their email addresses, by reading them on the BWGC website, or by reading them in the minutes notebook in the locker room. Diane Herring made the motion that the secretary's report be accepted as read. Brenda Crosby seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

2. Treasurer's Report: Jean Young

The balance in the treasury is \$1,456.00. Diane Herring made the motion to accept the treasurer's report. Shelley Drillen seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

3. Tournament Chair: Marilyn Rice

Marilyn talked about the variety of types of tournaments played: team events, gross and net events, and theme days. So many wet days limited the number of scheduled events that could be played. She explained that Golf Genius has caused some issues with pairings for our tournaments. This matter will be addressed next year.

She also talked about the need for less record keeping at our tournaments next year.

4. Handicapper Report: Sue Roberts

Sue passed out a list of handicaps for all players. She told us that of 34 playing members, handicaps for 21 players went up; handicaps for 13 players went down. This might be attributed to fewer tournaments being able to be played due to rainy conditions.

5. MSGA: Jean Young

If people have suggestions for the improvement of MSGA events and procedures, they need to be given to Sherrie Thomas at sherrie@mesga.org. The MSGA meeting will be held on October 17th at Val Halla.

Jean contacted Brian Bickford, Executive Director of MSGA, in regards to the \$5.00 increase in GHIN fees for next year. Jean read us his response explaining the increase. GHIN fees will increase from \$18 to \$23 per person.

6. Sponsorships: Jean Young

The amount of money raised from sponsorships in 2019 was \$1,100.00.
