**1. Secretary's Report: Gwen Archambault**

**Marilyn Rice:**

- The June 11<sup>th</sup> tournament will be a match play tournament in preparation for President's Cup.
- June 18<sup>th</sup> we will be playing at Traditions. Please contact Susan Payne. She needs to know if we are riding or walking and our handicap index.

**Suzanne Roberts: Handicapper**

- Everybody filled out a second scorecard.
- There is a problem on the green with the ball hitting the pin then bumping out. Sue suggested that we use a folded scorecard. That equals 5 1/2 inches. If the ball is out of the hole less than the scorecard, the putt will count as having gone in the hole. Suzanne made the motion that we use a scorecard to determine whether a ball has holed. Jean Bridges seconded it. The motion carried.
- This matter during championship play will be decided at the time of each tournament.
- Local rule for hole #2. To score that hole for posting, add: par + two strokes + the number of dots you would get on your card if cards were dotted. For the weekly tournament scorecard, put in the actual score but with the ten (10) stroke limit.

### **Liz Coffin: Web Master**

As soon as information comes to her, it will go on the BWGC website. This includes the weekly tournament schedule, the member list, and sponsors.

### **MSGA**
