Robin Ashe, President, opened the meeting at 1:30 by welcoming all to the meeting. She announced that the next time we meet, we will be able to use the deck.

Reports

Secretary: Gwen Archambault

Robin reminded people that the minutes of the October meeting had been sent to members via email, been added to the Minutes Notebook in the locker room, and posted on the BWGC website. She asked for approval of the minutes.

Anne Pooler mad the motion to accept the minutes of the October meeting, Ellen Libby seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer: Jean Young

- Last year the ending balance was \$948.00.
- The current balance in the treasury is \$3,157.06. \$2,010.00 has been collected in dues. \$200.00 has come from sponsorships. We have given \$25.00 to the American Lung Association in memory of Thomas Richard, Judy's husband.
- We have 47 members. Nine members are new to the club.

Sponsorship information: Jean Young

- Members of BWGC contribute to sponsorships. Janet Anderson will collect for The Sunshine Girls, Gwen Archambault will collect for the Snowbound Ladies of Muni. Members are encouraged to donate \$10.00 to one of these groups.
- The Executive Committee decided to resume sending out sponsorship letters this year after taking a year off because of COVID. Jean Bridges helped to revise the sponsorship letter, and Jean Young will send sponsorship letters shortly.

Weekly Tournament Chair: Claudette Amoroso

- The schedule will include a good variety of individual, team, and gross/net games. The scoring of the games will be compatible with Golf Genius.
- Explanation for each week's tournament will be given before participants go to their first tee box. This will happen near the tee area for hole #1.
- During this golf season there will be two tournaments held elsewhere than Muni. June 17th we will be at Penobscot Valley Country Club in Orono. On July 8th we will be at Traditions in Holden.

- It is our goal that members will have the opportunity to meet and golf with all members of our club throughout the season. Golf Genius does the pairings. If we find we are playing with the same people, we may have to work with the Pro Shop.

Handicapper: Sue Roberts

- If there are questions about rules of play, please bring them up during our lunches in Hero's Grill. Some rules may be addressed before tournament players leave the area of the first tee.
- Sue asked us to post our scores on the day of play. She is checking to be certain that this is being done. We are using the World Handicap System. Handicaps are changed daily in accordance with posted scores.
- After tournament play, both scorecards are to go to the Pro in the golf shop.

Our website is very valuable to our club. Robin talked about some of the things posted on the website: the weekly schedule, pictures taken during tournament play, and other pertinent information. We appreciate the time and effort that Liz spends on our behalf.

Special Positions are Needed:
