Co-President Marlene Viger reported to the club that Jean Young had resigned from her position as treasurer of the club. Marlene praised the many years of service Jean has given to this position and how instrumental she has been in giving her all to our club. Jean was not only treasurer, but she inherited the sponsorship work as well. Jean has always filled in where there was a need. Our club thanks you, Jean, for your time, effort, and service to our club. A replacement was found with Sandy Salsbury, and the transition is a smooth one. Jean will be available to assist Sandy and answer any questions. Sandy is familiar with Excel so we are in good hands. Thank you, Sandy, for stepping up to the plate.

Sandy then gave the **Treasurer's Report** as of July 5th.

- The current checkbook balance is at \$3,373.78 with several deposits this month for memberships and 1 expense for the chip in balls.
- Membership is at 46 with 37 having ghin through Bangor Muni, 8 having their ghin at other clubs, and 1 honorary member.
- We remain at 11 sponsorships. Gwen is still collecting for the Snowbirds while Robin is collecting for the Sunshine girls.

Maine Golf:

- Marlene mentioned how well Bangor women have done in state days including the TriState win for Maine, the first time in 14 years. Marlene also mentioned Springbrook, Belgrade, and Rockland all produced winners from our league. Go to the Maine State portal to see the results. The Maine Women's Amateur is in Brunswick in July.
- Karen Bamford brought up several items as she serves on the Women's Tournament Committee for Maine Golf.
 - Belgrade will no longer be a venue for the Metropolitan. Teams were excluded this year due to the tournament requirements. Belgrade is too popular a venue to be the site of tournament restrictions.
 - Karen addressed that there are new residence requirements for the Maine Women's Amateur, and that is causing some issues including Bailey Plourde will be unable to play in this year's competition.

Senior Women's Travel League: Bangor will be hosting the league on Monday, July 10th, 2023. Some of our members will be playing in it.

Weekly Tournament Chair: No report as Marilyn Rice was not in attendance.

Alternate Play Location for July 13th: Since this year, we go off site only once, a vote was taken by the club, and Penobscot Valley Country Club won by a close margin.
