Liz Coffin spoke regarding the President's Cup. A sign up sheet is posted in the locker room. You must sign up by June 26<sup>th</sup>. The first round is played June 30<sup>th</sup> -July 15<sup>th</sup>. The second round is played July 16<sup>th</sup> -August 2<sup>nd</sup>. The third round August 3<sup>rd</sup> -15<sup>th</sup>. Final round played August 16<sup>th</sup> -26<sup>th</sup>. Members have to have played three ladies days in the last 12 months to participate. Members handicaps on the day of the match will be in effect. Members are expected to arrange their own matches.

On July 22<sup>nd</sup>, the course is closed because of the GBO and we will play at Lucerne. After play, the girls are invited to Janice White's camp for lunch. Please bring a box lunch and what you wish to drink.

The Club Championship is to be played August 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. You must play two rounds with a member. Louise Shindler is in charge of this event. Everyone should play at the same time, under the same conditions.

The Executive Committee has requested to have a one-club invitational with Natanis at Bangor Muni on August 12. Marilyn Rice is in charge of format and Jan Skaggs is in charge of set up and decorations. Kathy Anderson and Janice White volunteered to help Jan. Marilyn may need volunteers to help with her duties.

It was unanimously voted to place a marker on hole #14 (ladies tee) in memory of Dick LaPointe.

Geri Halkett spoke concerning a past member of BWGC. Sharon Dauphinee is in dire need of back surgery and is trying to raise \$20K. So far, she is short of her goal. A

Seconded by Sandy Meehan and accepted by the membership.

Viola Kemp kindly offered to be our go to member for rules. She has good knowledge of the rules of golf and will be pleased to help clarify any rule that may pose a problem for our members. If she doesn't know the answer, she will find it and get back to us.

A sign up sheet was passed among the membership for our hole-in-one insurance. According to Liz Coffin, we voted at the Spring meeting to have anyone interested add \$1.00 to the fund annually. It carries over until we have a winner.

Marilyn Rice informed us that the membership booklet is on the web site. (Liz44.com) It includes standing rules, as well as, weekly tournament rules. It was noted that we still need to turn in 2 score cards on ladies day. One to Brian and the other in the black box in the locker room. She also mentioned the necessity to eliminate slow. The 10 shot rule was discussed. After 10 strokes, pick up the ball and place it on the green at the furthest point from the hole and putt out. It was also noted that we need a drop area designated, by Brian, on hole #2.

Sandy Meehan noted that flag positions were changed during play today. It will be mentioned to Brian and suggested this not happen again.
