# August 9th Invitational Tournament, "The Big Break"

To date, 6 people from outside of our club have said they will be participating in this tournament. It is hoped that many other members from other clubs will sign up. There is a sign-up sheet in the locker room for BWGC members.

The format of this tournament will be two best balls of four. Brian Enman and Marilyn Rice will do the pairings. Prizes will be awarded for first and second gross and first and second net scores, first and second team gross and net scores, and for "The Big Break" component of the tournament.

An estimated budget for the "The Big Break" was presented. Entry fees will cover greens fees, lunch, and some of the prizes. Entry fees are \$20.00 for participants who are members of Bangor Municipal Golf Course; \$35.00 for non-members. Based on 50 entrants, entry fees will bring in \$1450.

Expenditures for lunch, prizes, decorations, breakfast and greens fees are estimated at \$2100. It is estimated that \$650.00 will need to be taken from our treasury to cover the costs of the tournament.

Volunteers are needed to help with the breakfast and to help with registration on the day of the tournament.

## **Speed Up Play Tip**

Our tournaments are ready-play tournaments. Balls on the green do not always have to be marked. If people are ready to putt and someone is off the green going to their ball, people on the green may putt.

When someone is putting, do not stand in front or in back of them as that puts you in the line of play. Stay out of the putters eyesight.
