

June Monthly Golf Meeting

2. **August Theme Day:** No volunteers have come forth to do the August Theme Day.
3. **The Metropolitan** was discussed by its chairperson Jean Sweetzer. . She passed out a sign up sheet for food and workers for the 13th and 14th as the Metropolitan is at Bangor Muni those days. Jan Skaggs offered to do flowers for the tables. Jean Young and Brian Enman will do the rules. Each team will be \$92.00. No spotters will be necessary.
4. **Another honorary member: Geri Halkett** was honored with a cake and a beautiful peace plant in honor of her 80th birthday and her dedication to the Bangor Ladies' Golf Club. She will join the ranks of the 80 year old honorees to our golf club and will no longer need to pay for her membership to our group. Kathy Anderson presented the cake and said some nice words to Geri about her involvement with our club.
