Maine Finishes Second at NEWGA Championship

Massachusetts, with a team index of 3.1, captured the NEWGA Championship in Providence, Rhode Island in July. Maine battled to take second.

Fifteen WMSGA golfers qualified to compete in the event at Matacomet Country Club from July 7-9. Five players made the cut to play on the final day: Alexa Rancourt, Sable Oaks; Julie Aurie, Country View; Kate Merrill, Toddy Brook; Susan Gilpatric-Smart, Webhannet; and Stephanie Babin, Biddeford-Saco.

Alexa Rancourt finished fifth overall and second in the junior division. Other awards went to Ruth Colucci, who carded low net on day one, and Susan Gilpatric-Smart, who posted the low net score on day three and finished tied at 43 overall. Julie Aurie, playing in her first NEWGA tournament, also finished tied at 43. Kate Merrill finished tied at 55, Stephanie Babin tied at 60, and Whitney Hand tied at 72.

My two practice rounds went well and I got to play both days with two of my future Furman teammates, Stephanie Kenoyer and Julia Thead. We all had a good time playing together even though it poured cats & dogs on Saturday.

Tomorrow is the first round of stroke play, and I have to get some sleep since I have an early tee time. We will update you after the day is done. Thanks so much for all the support and positive vibes coming from the great state of Maine.

They also gave us breakfast and lunch everyday, and it was some of the most delicious food I have ever eaten! It truly was spectacular.

I may not have played as well as I would have liked but under the circumstances I couldn't be more proud of myself. It was my first USGA tournament ever and to only miss the cut by a few strokes AND feel like I played badly is a pretty big accomplishment for me. The course was immaculate and was set up to Tour standards so it was a great experience to play on it and see what a course would be like on the LPGA. Everyone with the USGA and Old Warson CC were all incredibly welcoming and friendly, especially the members, who made us feel right at home. It definitely was an experience that I will never forget and one that I hope to go through many more times in the future!

I wanted to thank everyone in Maine who has supported me and helped me, not only to get to St. Louis (which so many of you did and I couldn't have done it without you!) but also just in my journey so far as a golfer. Living in Florida and in Maine for the past few years, I have struggled sometimes as to which is my home. But when I have tournament experiences like the recent Maine Women's Championship and feel the support and community that I felt there, it is easy for me to see that Maine is undoubtedly where my roots are and it is a place I want to come back to and call home for a lifetime.
