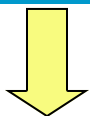

Mulligans: can be purchased before your round for \$1.00 each – 2 per person. A mulligan is simply a repeat shot or do over. Use them wisely.

Strings: can be purchased for \$1.00 per foot (minimum of 3 feet and maximum 10 feet). A string is simply an extension of your shot. If your ball rests closer to the hole than the length of string than it counts as in the hole. One time use only!!

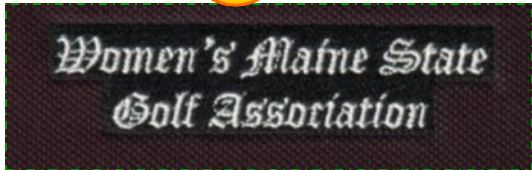


The 2009 Maine Mixed Championship will be contested at the Rockland Golf Club **Sunday August 9th**. The event features amateur teams consist-

- ing of a male and a female competing in a Scotch Ball Modified Pinehurst. In this format, both players hit drives from the appropriate tee and then play their partner's ball for the second shot.
- One ball is then selected and players alternate hitting until holed out. The process is repeated for each subsequent hole.

One player per team must have a current membership in either the MSGA, WMSGGA, or SMWGA in order to submit an entry application.
