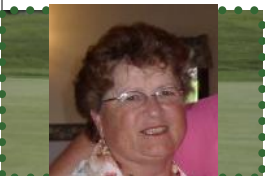

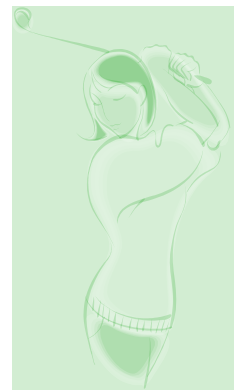


**July 26-28, 2010 WMSGA CHAMPIONSHIP**
